Our Focus

Our Day Services offers an array of options focused on increasing community inclusion, promoting independence, and enhancing opportunities for choice and decision making.

We provide a structured setting and a supportive environment to participants. The Day Services program enables participants to live and work in the community by teaching daily living skills. Consumers in the Day Services program can participate in activities such as bowling, swimming, concerts, movies, museum visits, and other local events.



Long Term Goals

Our team will develop an Individualized Service Plan for each consumer, partnering with the consumer to work with family members, guardians and providers.

The ultimate goal is to promote and encourage the development of consumers' skills in all areas of their lives, including: communication, socialization, personal and emotional

skills building, leisure and recreational activities, vocational and pre-vocational activities, and financial management.

Eligibility Standards

In order to be eligible for Clarity Care Day Services a person must:

- Have a developmental disability or other chronic condition
- Be an adult (18 years or older)
- Have the means to pay for partial or full cost of services, unless fees are waived
- Be in need of services and demonstrate the potential to benefit from participation

The individual and his/her representative are required to participate in:

- An assessment process to determine the needs of the individual
- Designing an individualized service plan
- Reviewing and updating service plans as desired or scheduled

Rates for Day Services are based upon the needs of the individual. We provide group rates (1:3 or 1:4 staffing ratio) and intensive rates (1:1 staffing).



We provide an environment that allows for individual needs and preferences, either one-on-one or in a group setting. The center provides rooms for small group activities and therapies, areas for large group activities, a lounge area, a computer lab, and a full kitchen. The entire facility is wheelchair accessible.

An outdoor area features relaxing green space, a gazebo, and walking path. The center also has vehicles available to meet the transportation needs of participants.
